Page 3760, first line, the text “Our current study had similar findings” should read “Our study observed an increase in the exposure to HRS-1780 with both mild and moderate renal impairment compared with normal renal function, which however, was not statistically significant. Also, the increased exposure of HRS-1780 was comparable between mild and moderate renal impaired groups, which is different from the findings in finerenone”.
