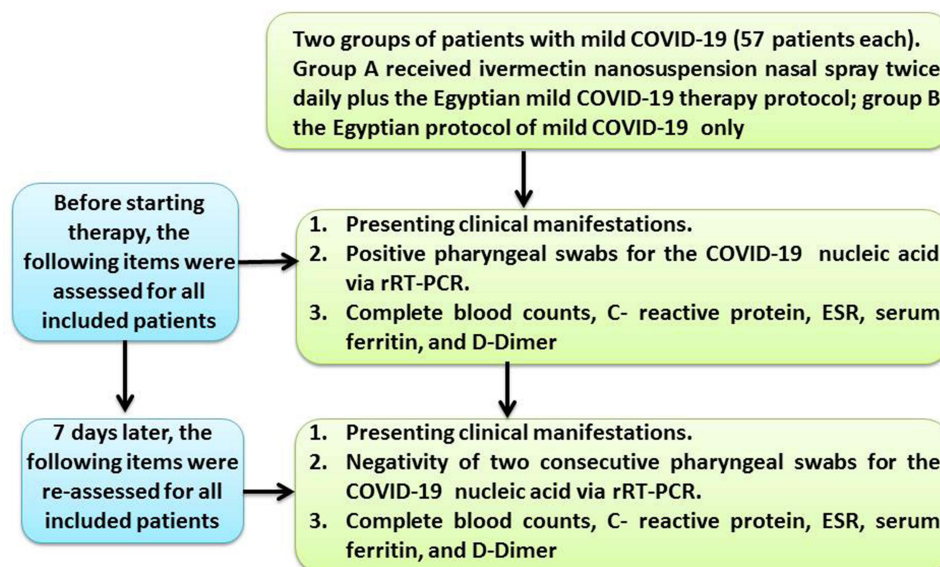


Figure 1 Flow chart of the study design.
