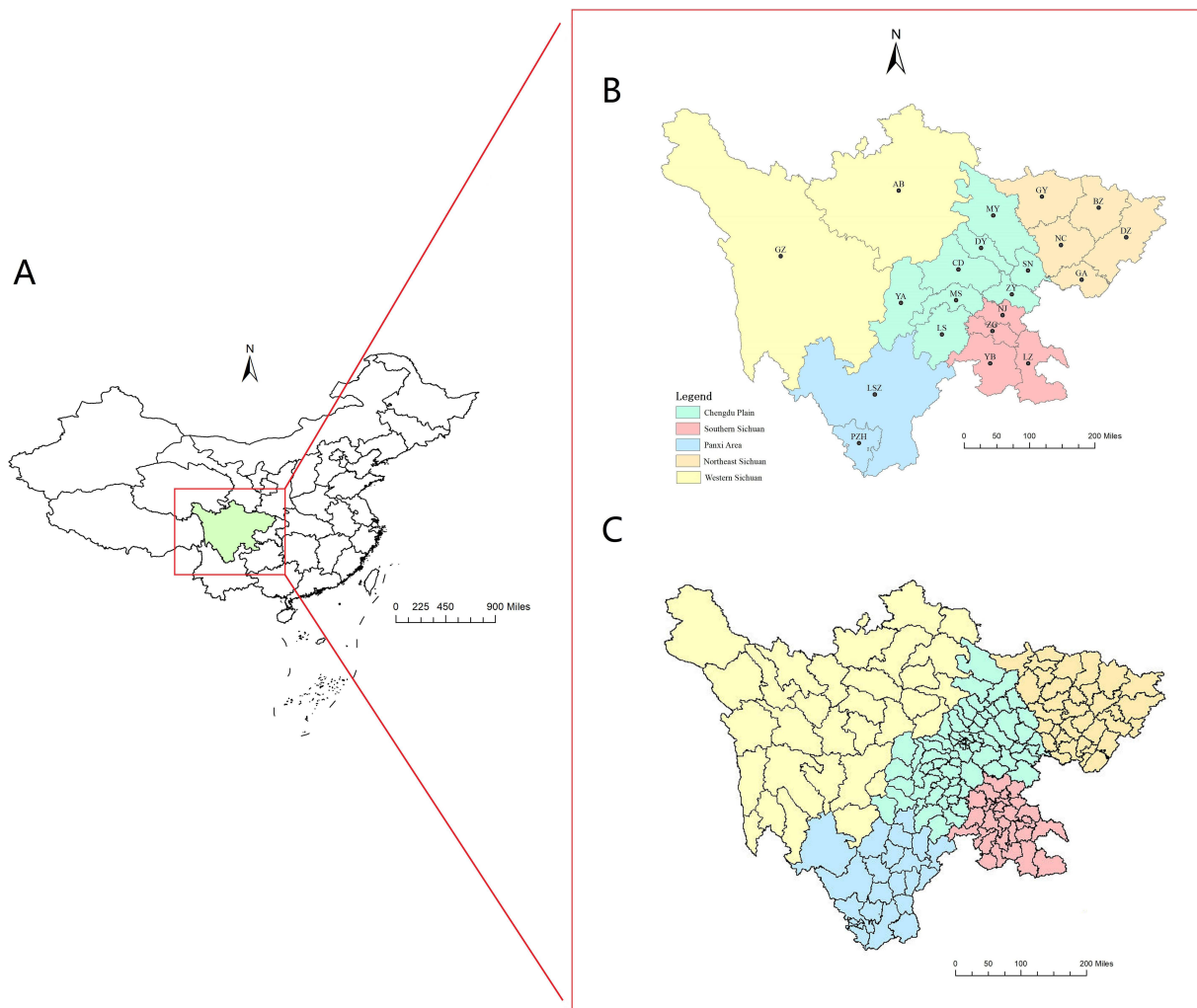


Figure 1 (A–C) The geographical distribution of Sichuan in China.

Figure 1A on page 6130 contains incomplete boundary depictions. The updated Figure 1 should read as follows.
