There is an error in the text on page 19:

“Alpha-glucosidase inhibitors are infrequently used in the treatment of T2DM.³ These agents competitively inhibit the absorption of alpha-glucosidase along the brush border of the small intestine, which slows gut absorption of carbohydrates and ultimately reduces post-prandial blood glucose.^{34–36}” should read as “Alpha-glucosidase inhibitors are infrequently used in the treatment of T2DM.³ These agents competitively inhibit the degradation of complex carbohydrates along the brush border of the small intestine, which slows gut absorption of metabolized carbohydrates and ultimately reduces post-prandial blood glucose.^{34–36}”
