

Supplementary File 1: The Ohio State Wexner Medical Center Value Scorecard for Physician-led Sourcing Projects.

Criteria	Description
Product Improves Patient Outcomes (Quantifiable)	Results can be measured and are supported by data. Ex. LOS, SSI.
Level of Clinical Evidence	Level and type of evidence
Physician or Clinical Preference	Benefit that is not quantifiable. Familiarity, ease of use, relationships, flexibility
Patient Safety	Prevents unintended or unnatural negative events
Staff Safety	Prevents unintended or unnatural negative events
Standardization	Reduces the number of Suppliers and/or SKU, standardizes clinical practice
Clinical Efficiency	Saves clinical time
Operational Efficiency	Saves operational time
Revenue	Revenue Impact
Cost (Savings)	Cost Impact
Strategy	Aligns with Health System strategic priorities
Breadth and Depth of Portfolio	Meets needs with limited exceptions
Inventory Impact	Adds or removes inventory
Effort to Implement	Ensures the effort is commensurate with impact/benefit
Delivery	Provides timely training, support and resources upon delivery
Sustainability and Diversity	Impact of product(s) to the environment or support of diverse businesses
Term(s)	Length of agreement, other business terms
Vizient Contract Admin Fees Impact	Spend contributes to admin fee target
Supply Assurance	Reliable delivery of goods and services
