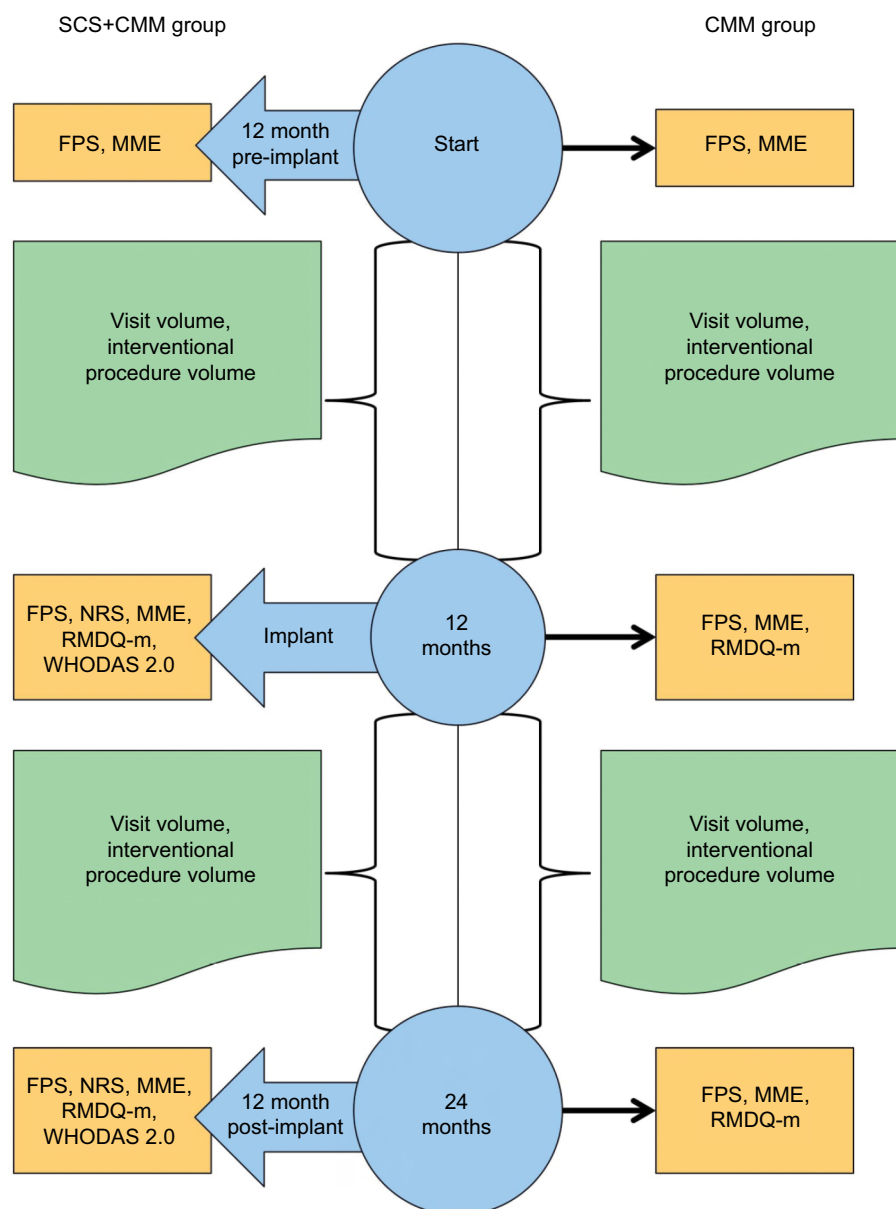


Figure 1 Time points of data extraction from medical record during study period.
