

Commonly Identified Errors:

Spelling Errors:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Simple Spelling Errors	"The authors searched for relevant studeies using Google Scholar."	"Studies" is spelt incorrectly.	"The authors searched for relevant studies using Google Scholar."
Space Missing Between Words	"We measured the heart rateand blood pressure of each patient."	No space between "rate" and "and".	"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."
Duplicated Words	"We measured measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."	"Measured" is repeated.	"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."

Grammatical Errors:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Missing Articles (a/an/the)	"We measured heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."	Missing article ("the") between "measured" and "heart".	"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."
Misuse of Prepositions (e.g., in/at/on/of/for/to)	"We believe this treatment plan is beneficial for the treatment of patients for hospital."	Incorrect preposition used – should be "in" rather than "for".	"We believe this treatment plan is beneficial for the treatment of patients in hospital."
Subject-Verb Agreement (Singular vs Plural Subjects and Verbs)	"We found five genes that is upregulated in cancer."	Incorrect verb used – as the noun "gene" is plural ("genes"), the attached verb should also be plural ("are").	"We found five genes that are upregulated in cancer."
Verb Tenses (Incorrect Tense Used)	"As our results shown , this treatment plan appears to be beneficial for the treatment of patients."	The results are currently being presented, so present tense should be used in this sentence ("show").	"As our results show , this treatment plan appears to be beneficial for the treatment of patients."
Noun Number (Incorrect Use of Plurals)	"We found five gene that are upregulated in cancer."	As there is more than one gene (five), the noun "gene" should be plural ("genes"), not singular.	"We found five genes that are upregulated in cancer."

Missing Words:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Missing Words	"Patients under the age of 18 excluded from the current study."	The word "were" is missing from the sentence. Note that the word after the missing word will be highlighted in the MLA report.	"Patients under the age of 18 were excluded from the current study."
